## Why is Literacy for ME important?

- Literacy often makes the difference between poverty and self-sustainability. Robust literacy skills are critical prerequisites for the work of the 21st century.
- When individuals are highly literate, they are better able to participate as citizens, consumers, employees, and parents.
- Ensuring that all Mainers achieve high levels of literacy requires everyone—families, community partners, schools, and state organizations.
- Capable, well-educated children are the foundation of a prosperous and sustainable society. Maine's future prosperity is dependent on their success.
