## Did you know?

- Plant groups can be destroyed partially or in full depending on the need.
- Plant count destroyed will auto-update the plant count remaining in a plant group.

# Split Plant Groups – New functionality

Plant Groups can be split into plant group tags of different quantities.

Plant groups cannot be split into plant groups that do not have a large enough max plant count.

## Use Cases

- Plants begin growing at different speeds in larger plant groups.
- Plans change and a user decides to designate a portion of a group as mother plants.
- A user identifies a need to harvest sections of large group on different days.

- Multiple small plant groups are identified that could be tracked as one large group for harvesting purposes.
- A group tag being underutilized is identified and a user opts to merge plant groups together.

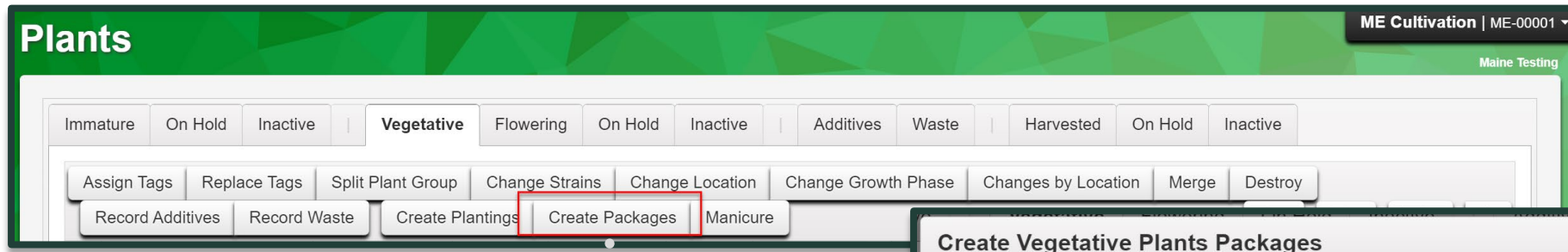

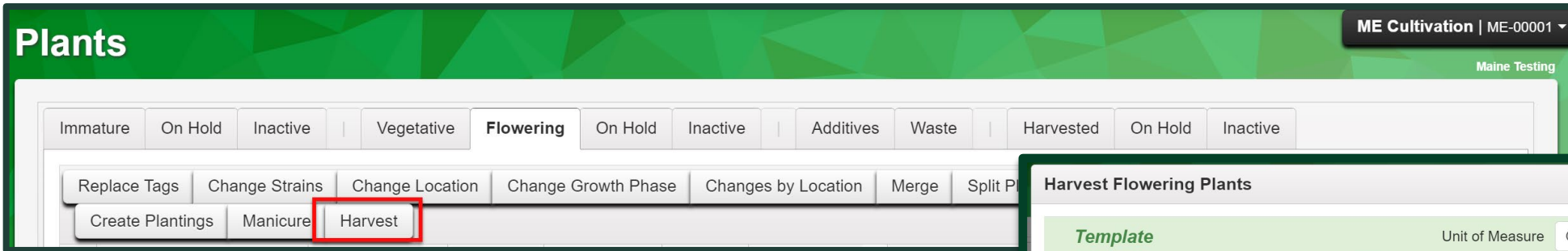
# Creating Packages from Plant Groups



- Plant groups are packaged in full, however, multiple plant groups of the same strain can be pulled into a singular package.
- The split plant group feature would be used to separate a portion of a group for packaging purposes.

# Harvesting Plant Groups



- Flowering plant groups are harvested as a group, capturing the total wet weight of the plant group.
- Harvests can consist of multiple same-strain plant groups.

## Important note

A new workflow is required for harvesting plant groups vs. individual plants.

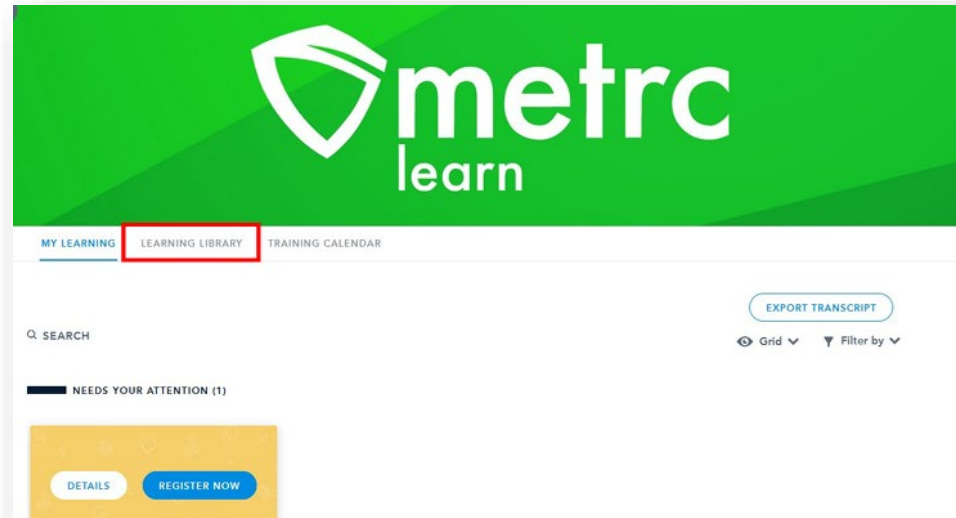
