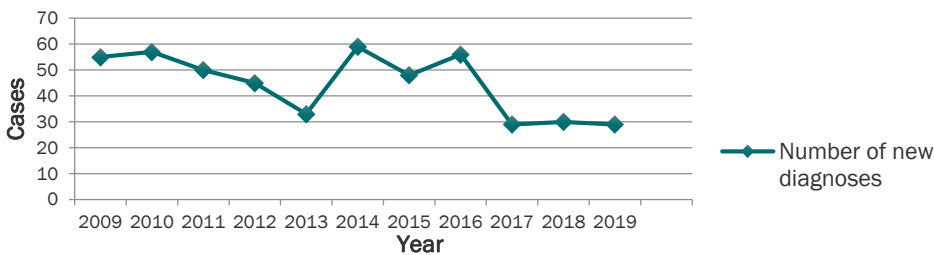

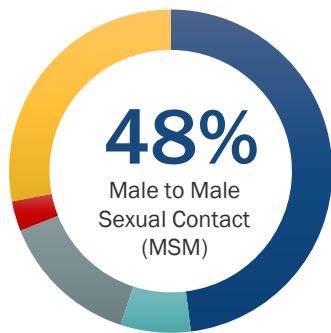

## Prevention:



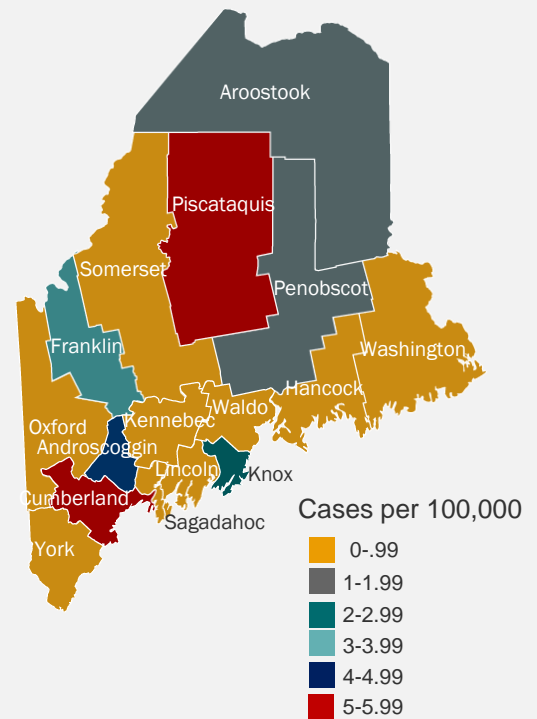
- Proper condom use
