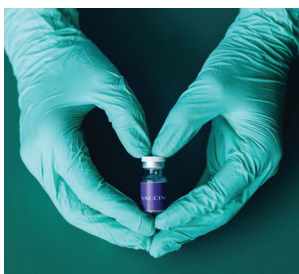

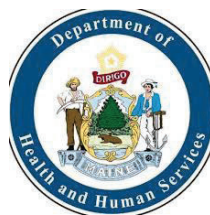

What does “317 Vaccine” Mean for Me?

Section 317 of the Public Health Service Act authorizes the federal purchase of vaccines for the community, including adults aged 19 years and older who are uninsured or underinsured.

317 vaccines have been used to meet the needs of priority populations; most recently this has been uninsured adults. It has helped to reduce the spread of dangerous and deadly diseases through vaccination.



What 317 vaccines are available for me?

- Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis)
- HPV
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Hepatitis A/B
- MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- Varivax (chickenpox)
- Pneumococcal
- Meningococcal ACWY
- Meningococcal B
- Shingrix (shingles)

Additional Recommended Vaccines

- **All adults:** Seasonal influenza, pneumococcal, and COVID-19.
- **Before/During Pregnancy:** including influenza and Tdap
- **Enrolling in College or the Military**
- **International Travel**

What does it cost?

317 vaccines are available at no cost* for adults 19 years and up who are either uninsured or underinsured (if your insurance does not cover vaccines, or only covers certain vaccines).

**Your doctor's office may charge an admin fee. Even if you cannot afford the fee, you will not be turned away.*
