

Exporting Data from Tableau Dashboards

Look for the **Download symbol**  at the top right of the dashboard

High School Graduation Rate

The four-year rate is the number of students who graduate in four years with a high school diploma, divided by the number of students who form the adjusted cohort for the graduating class. The fifth and sixth year rates reflect the number of graduating students who took five and six years, respectively to graduate from high school.

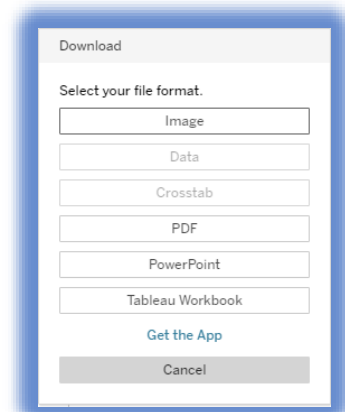
