State Local Foods Fund (LFF)

Grown or produced in Maine.

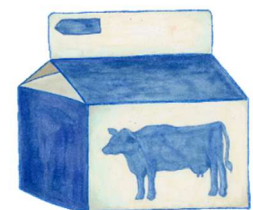
- Fruits and vegetables (whole, cut, pureed)

- Honey, maple syrup
- *Allowable processed and valued-added foods approved by Maine DOE*



Supply Chain Assistance (SCA)

Domestically grown in the U.S.

- Fruits and vegetables (whole, cut, pureed)
- 100% juice*
- Apple cider*
- Fresh or frozen fish
