The Maine Department of Education is not responsible for providing any funding for scholarship recipients.

Applications will be reviewed by a panel comprised of a representative from the Spanish Consulate, members of the FLAME board and the Maine Department of Education World Language Specialist. This selection committee is solely responsible for determining the individuals who receive the scholarship. To be considered, a teacher must:

hold the appropriate professional certification for the position,

- be employed by a Maine public school including a public charter school or publicly-supported secondary school, and
- be actively teaching students at least 50% of full-time for school year 2018-2019

The following criteria will be considered when reviewing applications: if the applicant teaches in a district where 50% or more of students are eligible for free and reduced lunch, prior experience abroad, and innovation in how the experience will enrich your instruction and how learning will be shared with the larger Maine world language community.
