Procurement Review Report Lisbon School Nutrition Program

A procurement review of the Lisbon School Nutrition Department was conducted to ensure compliance with Federal Regulations 2 CFR 200, 7 CFR 210, as well as applicable local laws.

<u>Code of Conduct</u>- The Code of Conduct, as required by 2 CFR 200.318(c)(1), was reviewed. There were no findings.

<u>Procurement Procedures</u>- Documented procurement procedures were not available.

Required Corrective Action- Develop procurement procedures for the school nutrition department as required by federal regulations. Resources are available on our website. Submit a copy to the reviewer by May 30, 2021.

<u>Micro-Purchases</u>- Micro-purchase procedures were followed. Federal law requires that micro-purchases be reasonable and equitably distributed among qualified suppliers. Receipts must be kept as documentation. There were no findings.

Small Purchases- None available for selection.

<u>Formal Purchases</u>- The Lisbon School Nutrition Program is a member of the Merrymeeting Consortium buying group. Formal contracts for prime vendor and dairy were reviewed. The findings are as follows:

- The solicitation was not publicly advertised in a state-wide newspaper
- The solicitation was missing the following:
 - o applicable contract provisions and certifications
 - o Federal and State Non-discrimination statements
 - o Language that supports the use of small, minority and women's businesses, when possible
 - o Correct appeal process
 - o Code of Conduct
 - o Notification that a market basket analysis is used in evaluation
 - o Clear and accurate descriptions and estimated quantities for evaluation
 - o All factors used in the evaluation

Required Corrective Action- The formal solicitation document needs to be revised and re-bid for school year 2021. Submit revised documents and a copy of the public advertisement to the reviewer by May 30, 2021. Submit a copy of the signed contract to the reviewer by June 15, 2021.
