Procurement Review Report Bangor School Nutrition Program Review Period SY 2019/2020

A procurement review of the Bangor School Nutrition Department was conducted. The purpose of this review is to ensure compliance with Federal Regulations 2 CFR 200 and 7 CFR 210 as well as applicable local laws when procuring goods and services for the school nutrition department.

Code of Conduct- No findings.

<u>Procurement Procedures</u>- It was observed that documented procurement policies did not included the requirement to take steps to assure that small, minority and women's business enterprises and labor surplus firms are used when possible (2 CFR 200.321). It would be beneficial to include this in the written procedures to document that the practice is being done.

Micro-Purchases- The School Nutrition Department does not complete micro-purchases.

Small Purchases- The School Nutrition Department does not complete small purchases.

Formal Purchases- No findings.

<u>Corrective Action-</u> Corrective action is not required. The Bangor School Nutrition Department has worked hard over the year to ensure their formal bids meet all requirements. Thank you for all of the work.
