## SY 2021 Procurement Review Report Millinocket School Nutrition Program

A procurement review of the Millinocket Public Schools Nutrition Department was conducted to ensure compliance with Federal Regulations 2 CFR 200, 7 CFR 210, as well as applicable local laws.

Code of Conduct- No findings.

<u>**Procurement Procedures-**</u> The Procurement Procedures in DJ-R Federal Procurement manual specifically noted that it was not applicable to Child Nutrition Programs.

<u>Micro-Purchases</u>-No findings, the nutrition program correctly follows micro-purchase procedures. Federal law requires that micro-purchases be reasonable and equitably distributed among qualified suppliers. Receipts must be kept as documentation.

<u>Small Purchases</u>-Millinocket Schools follows small purchase procedures for both bread and milk. The solicitation documents for these items did not provide product specification that included the Buy American Provision.

Formal Purchases- Not applicable, the school food authority does not conduct formal purchases.

*Procurement Procedures Required Corrective Action-* The Federal Procurement Manual DJ-R will need to be revised to remove the lines that exempt the Nutrition Programs. Revise and submit a copy to the State Agency.

*Small Purchase Procedures Required Corrective Action* -Submit a template of a solicitation document to be used in the future with buy American language included for product specifications. **Date Due: March 1, 2021**
