<u>Procurement Procedures</u>- The district Procurement Procedures reference Policy DJR- Federal Procurement Manual. The manual listed exceptions to the procedures, including Federal Child Nutrition Programs. This is incorrect as all federal child nutrition programs follow federal procurement regulations, which are described in the manual.

Required Corrective Action: Remove incorrect language and send updated Federal Procurement Manual to the reviewer.

<u>Formal Purchases</u>- RSU 54 is a member of the Kennebec Alliance buying group. Corrective Action had been required for the formal contract for this group.
