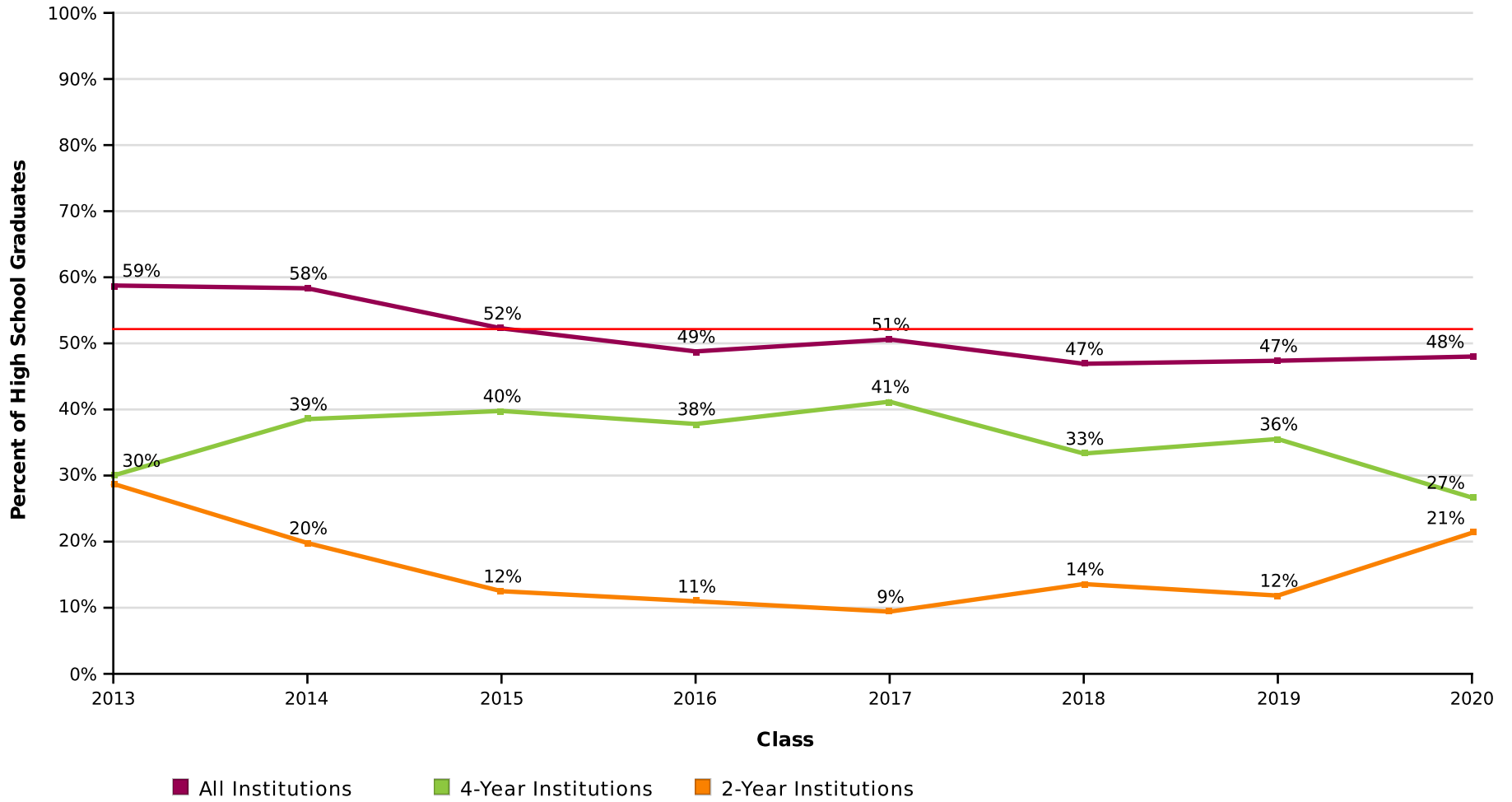

Percent of Students Enrolled in College at Any Time During the First Year After High School by Institutional Level

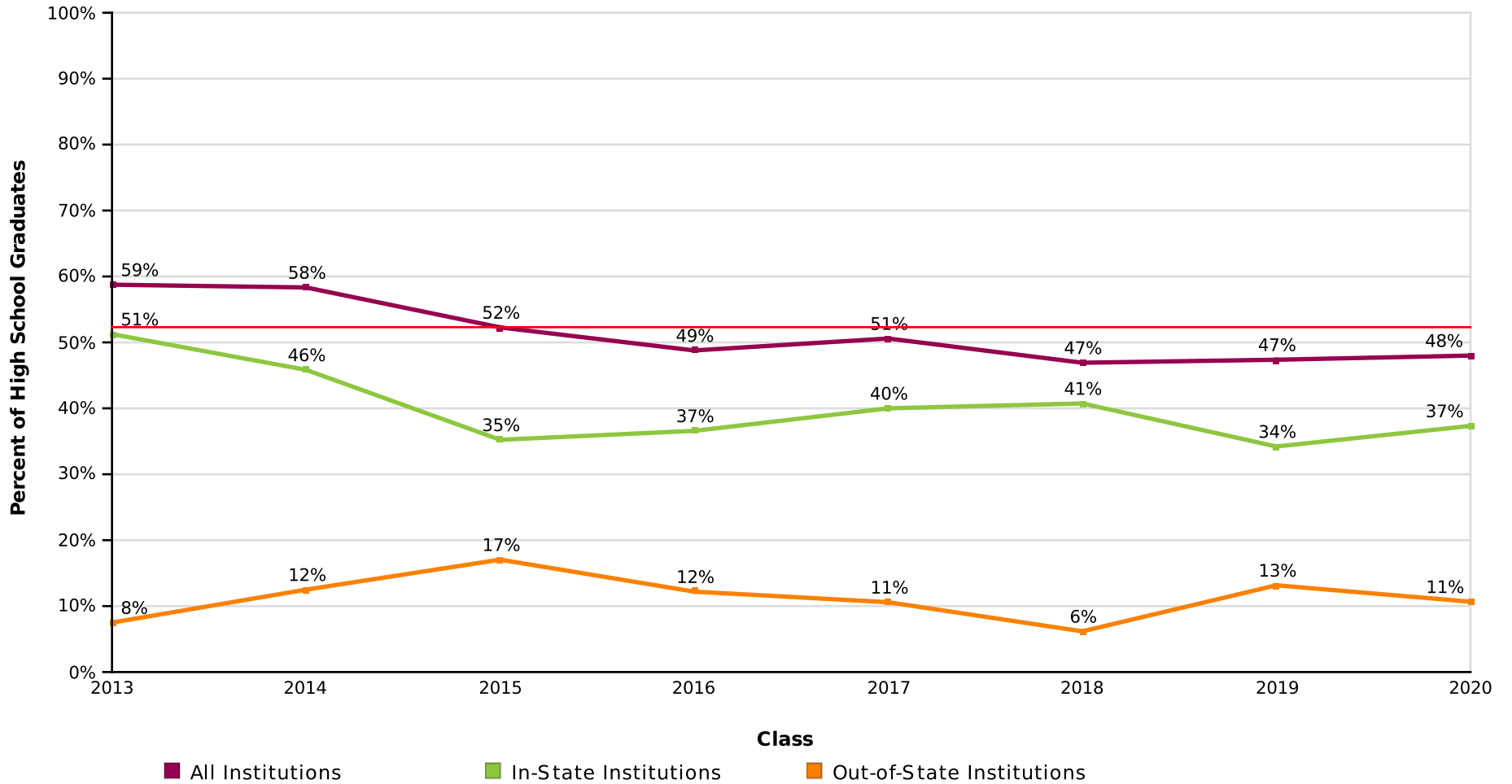

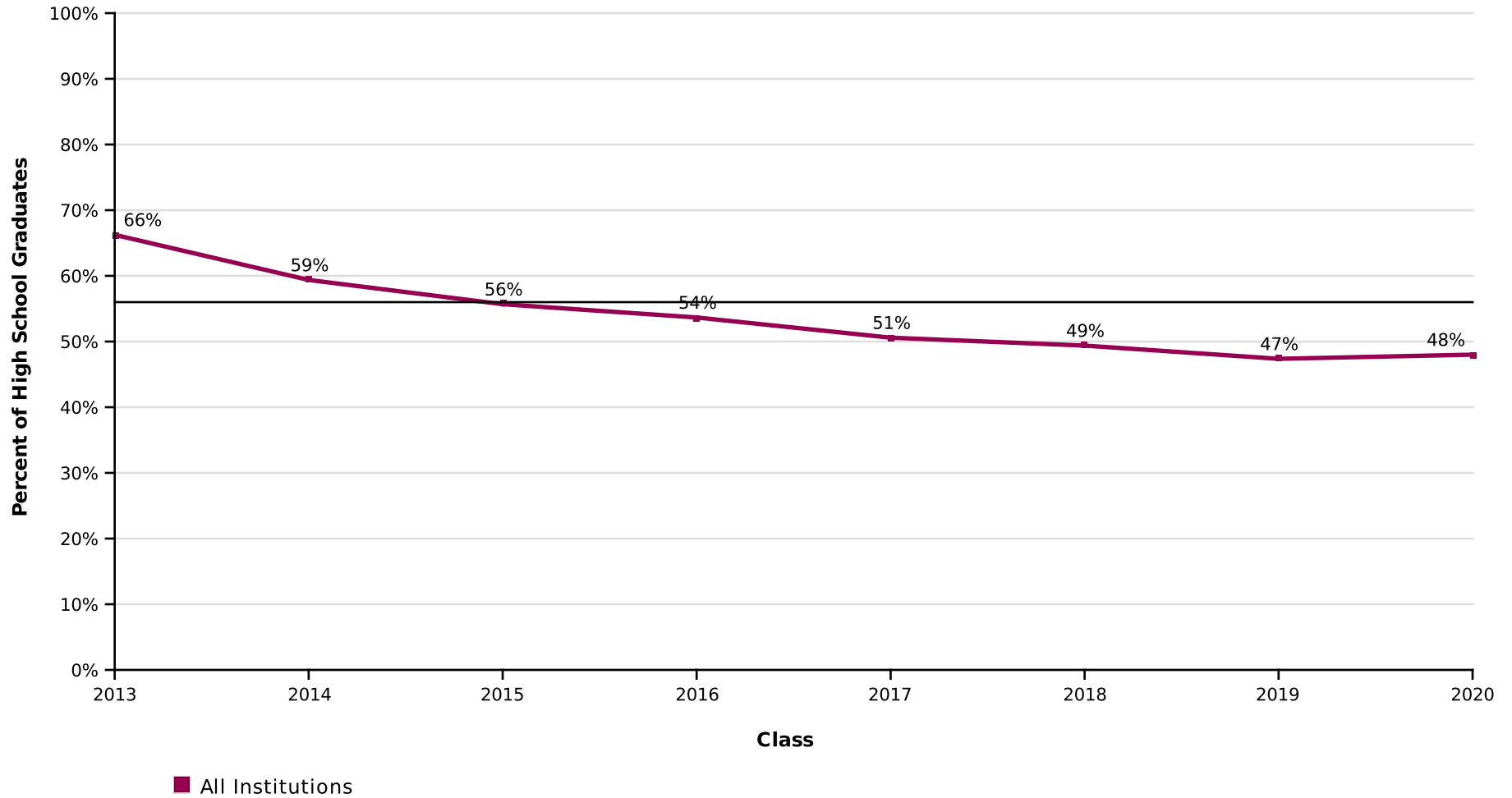

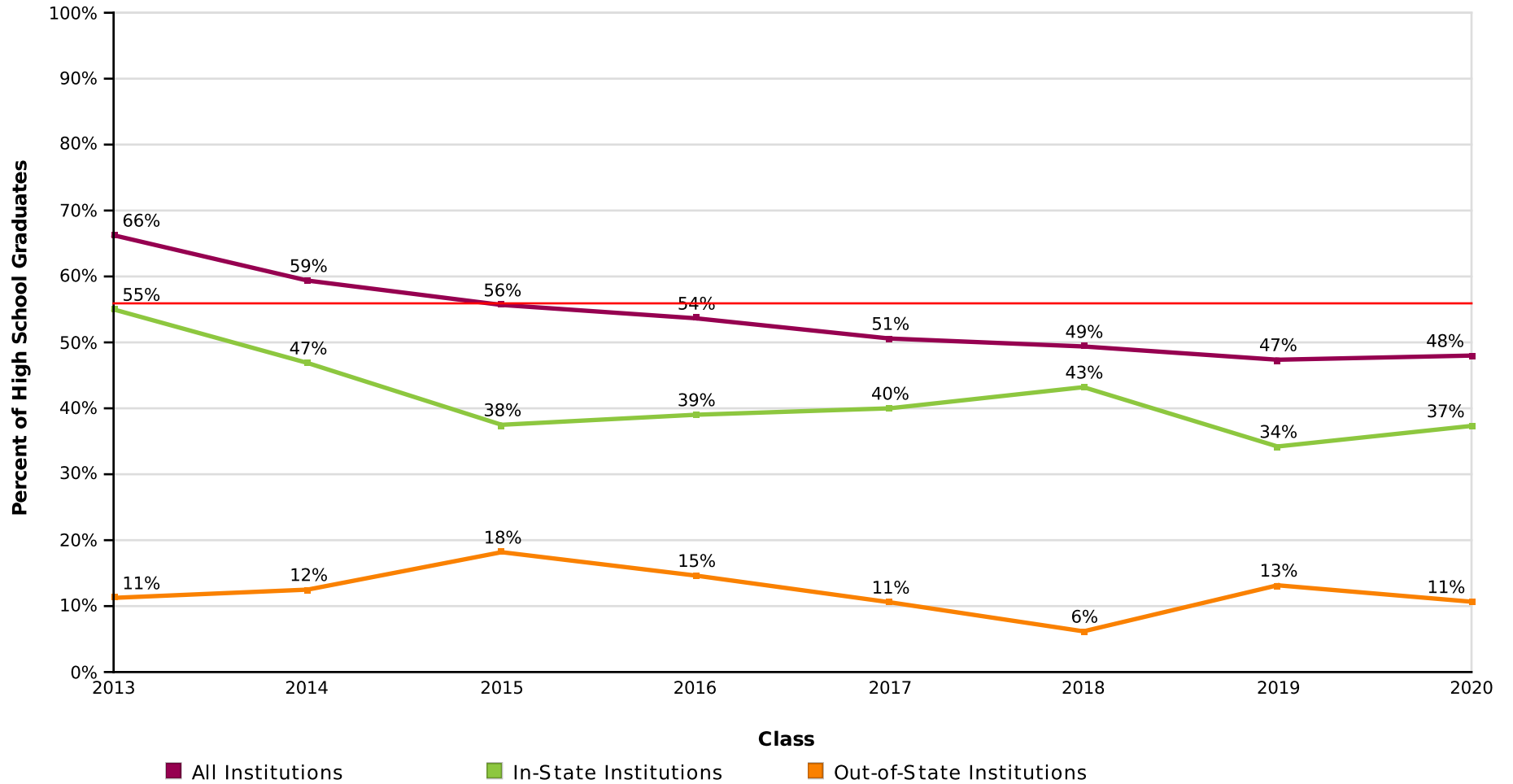

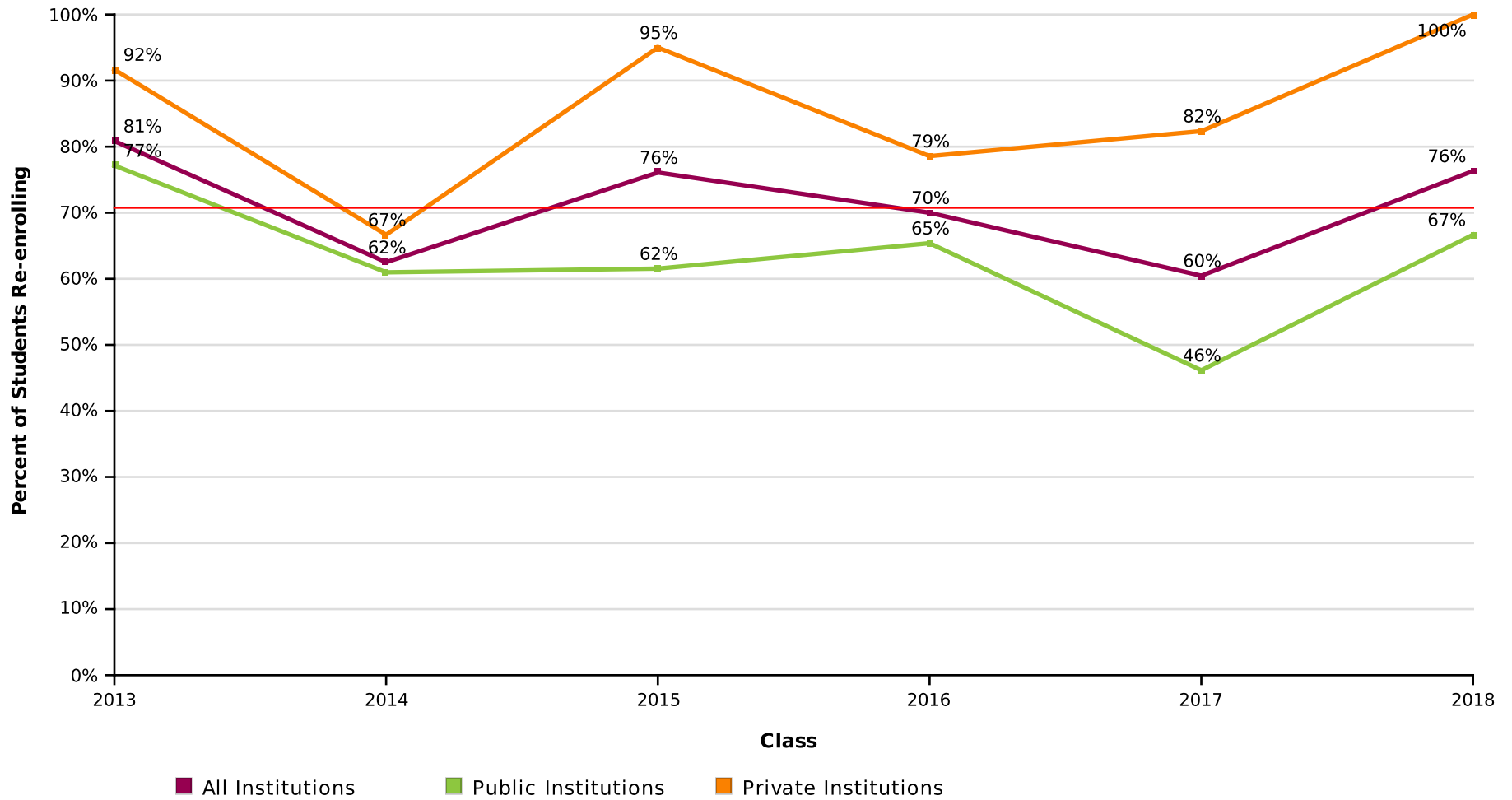

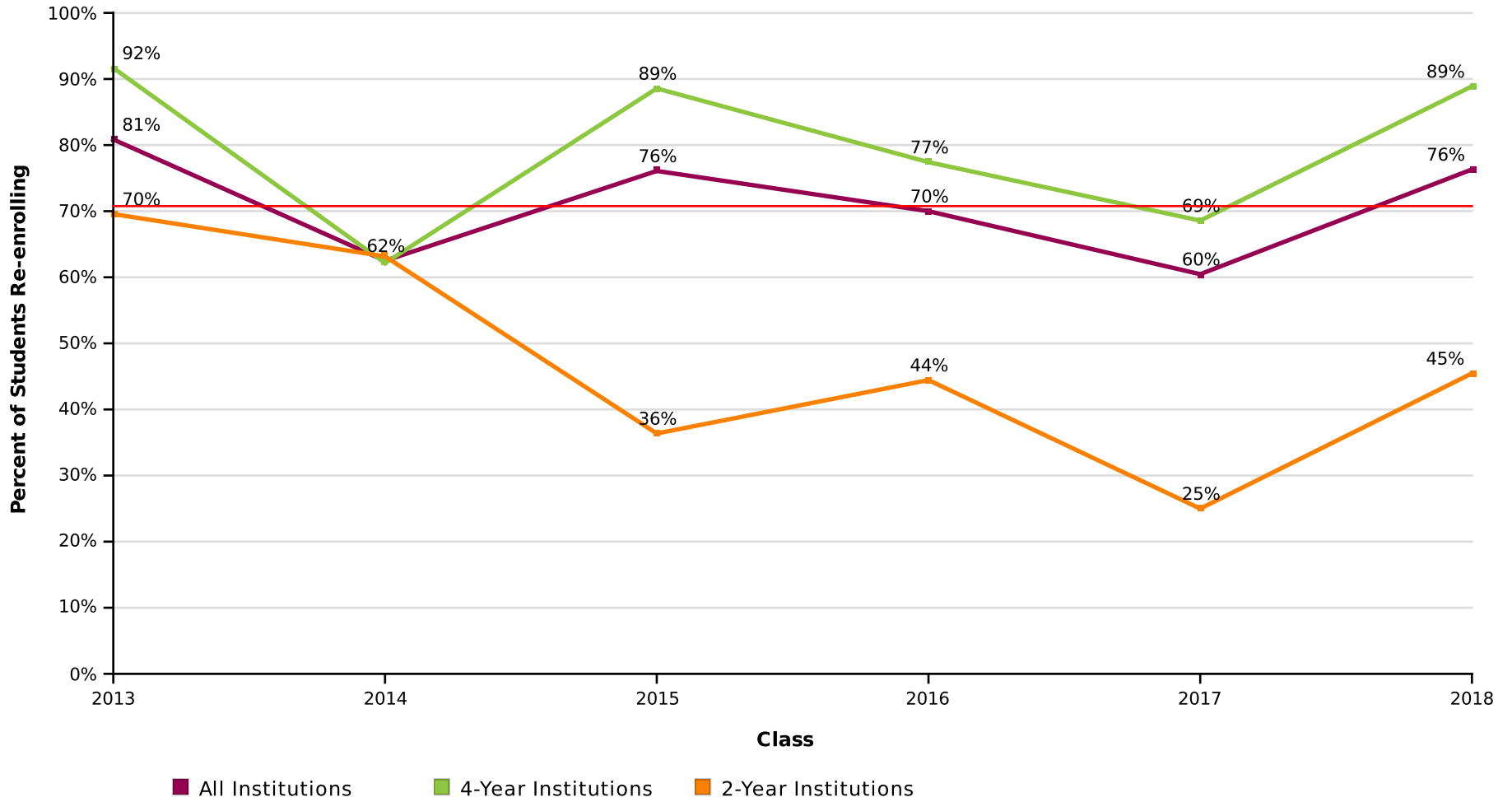

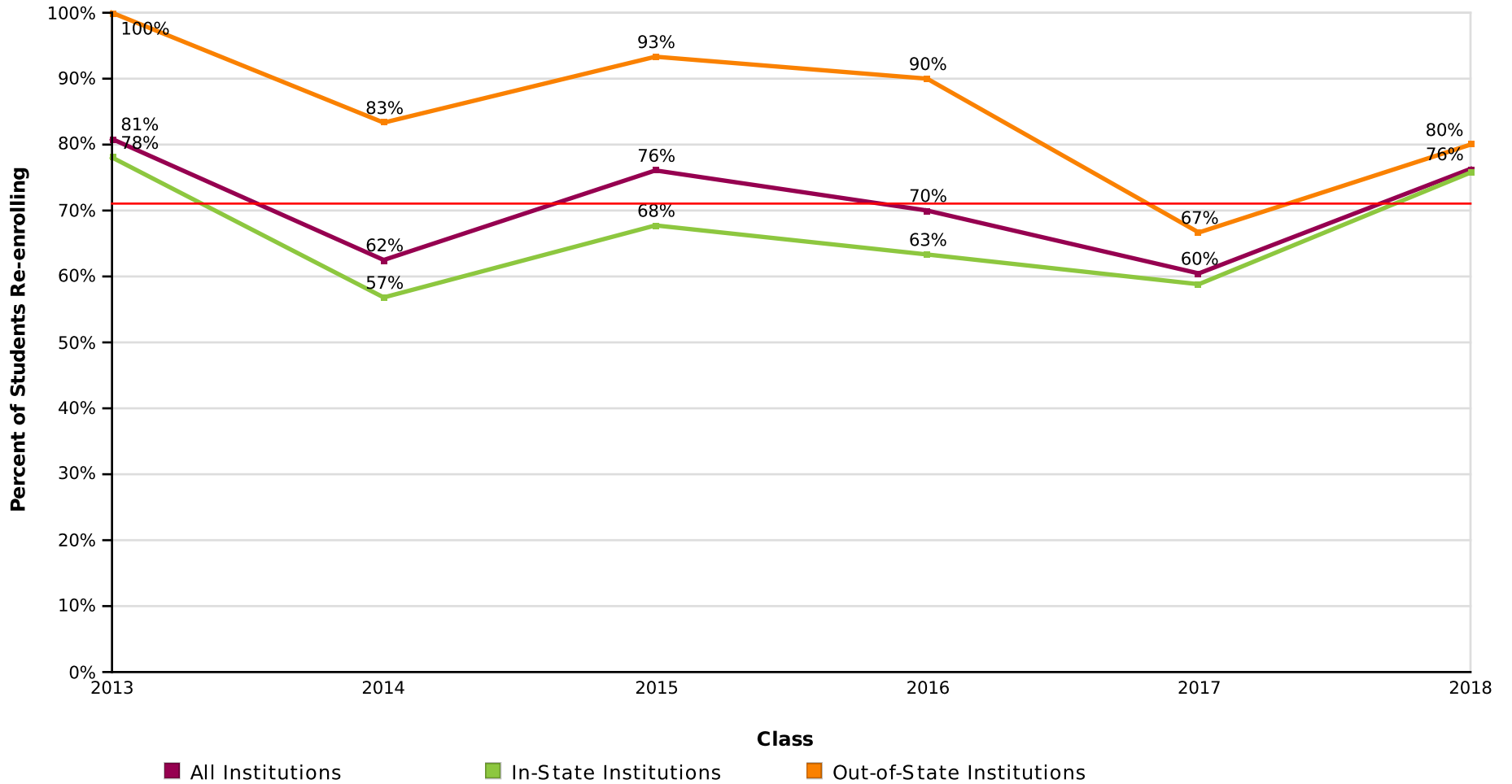

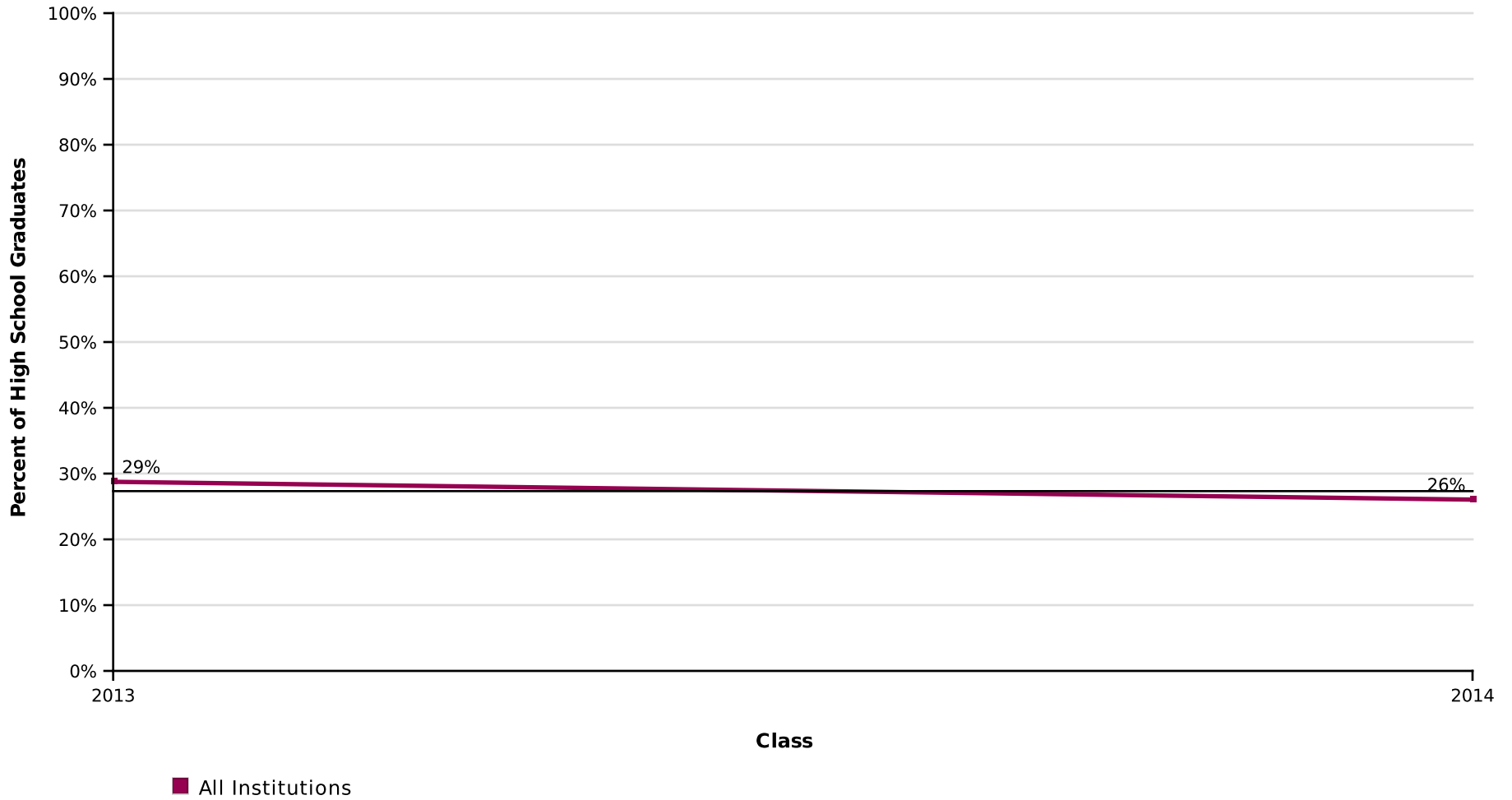

Percent of High School Class Who Completed a Degree Within Six Years

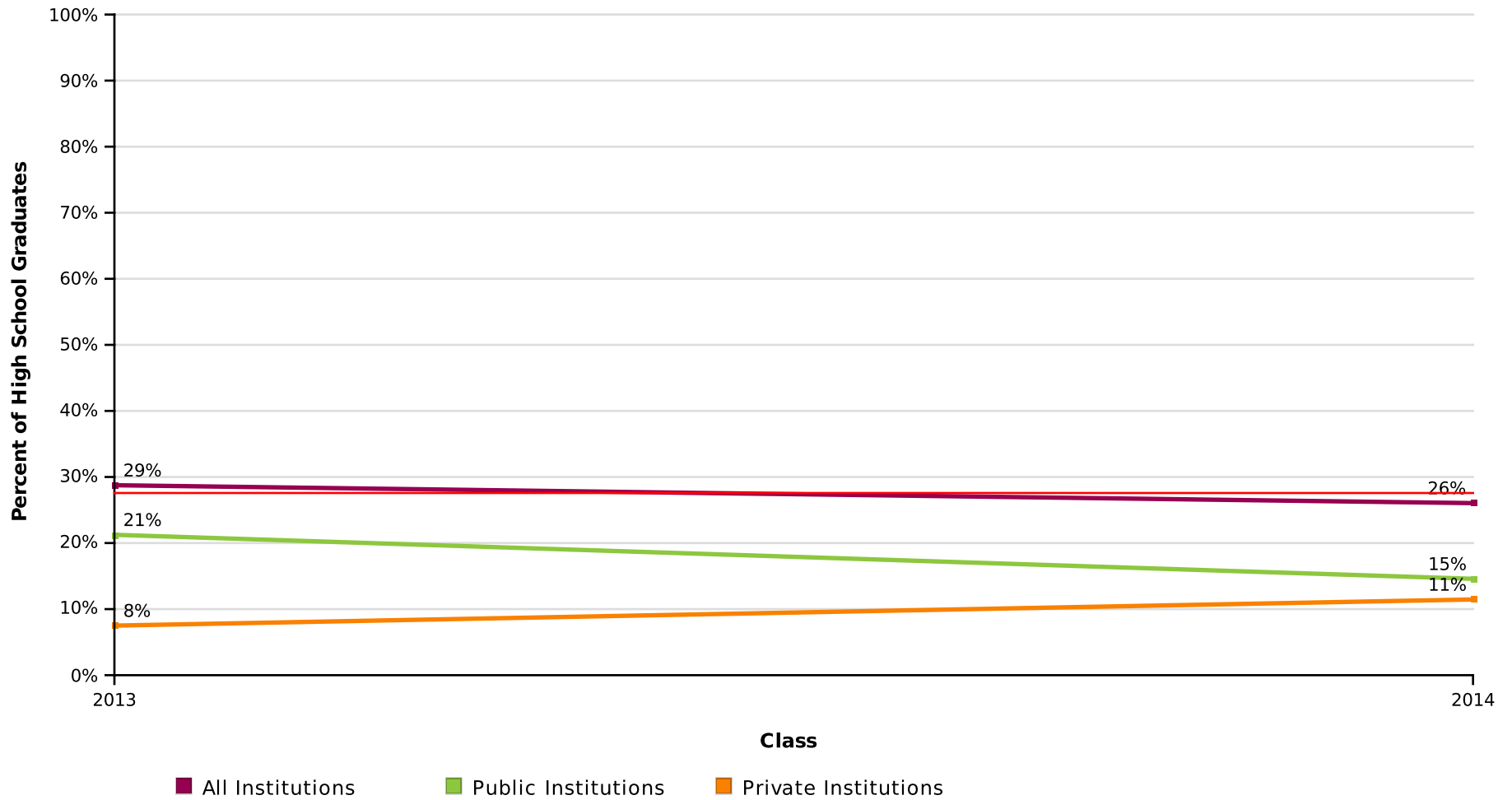

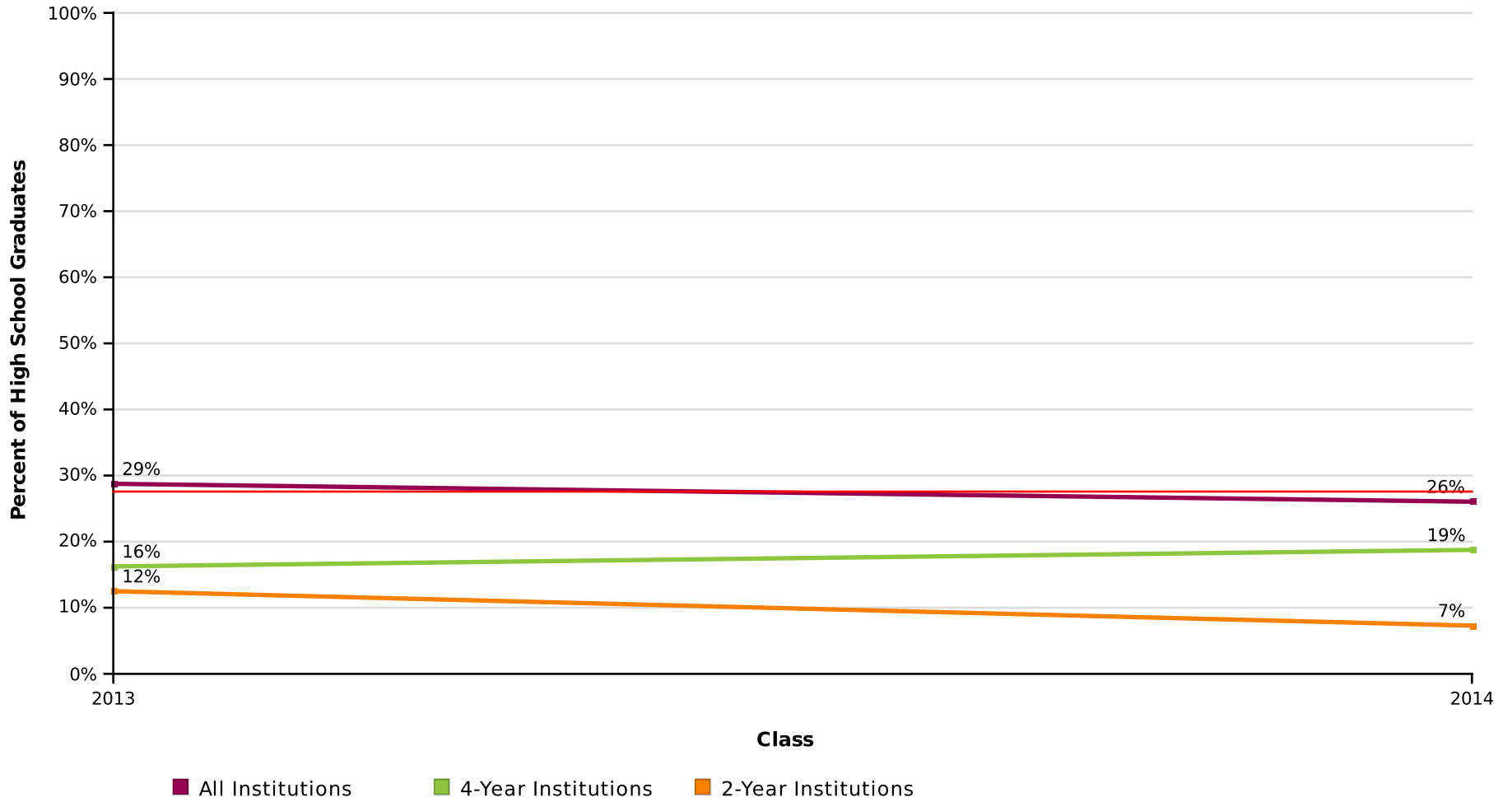

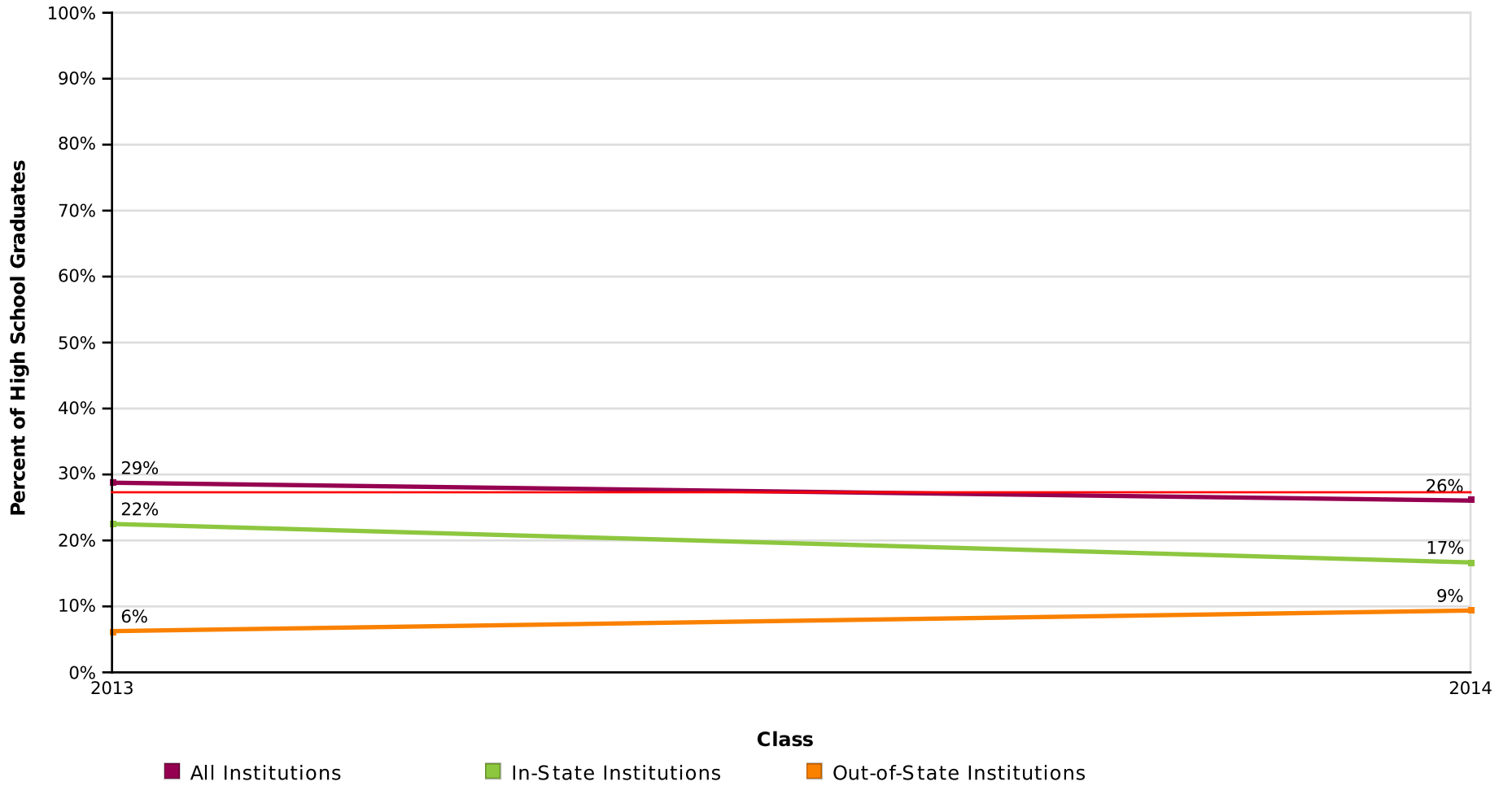

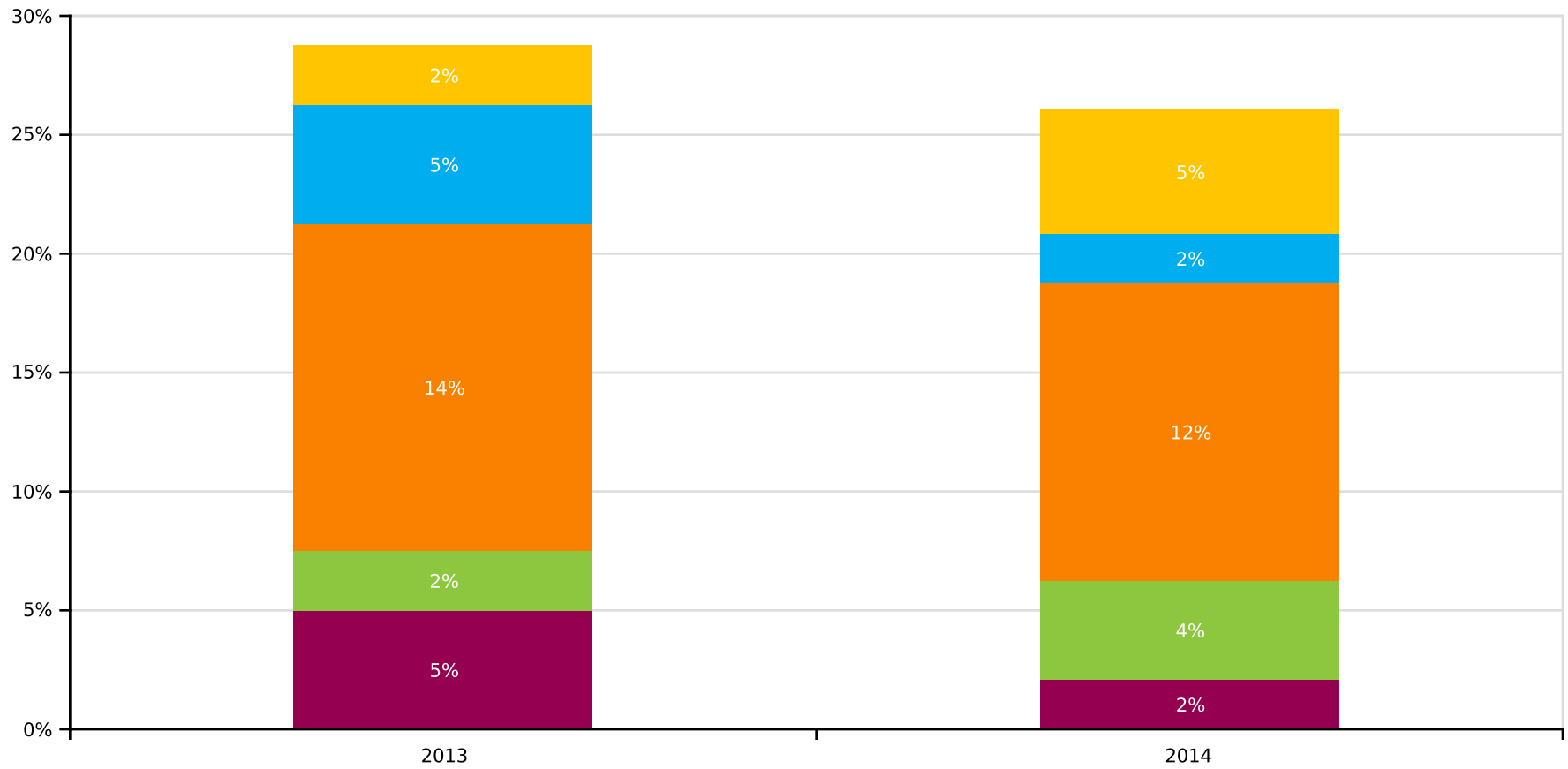

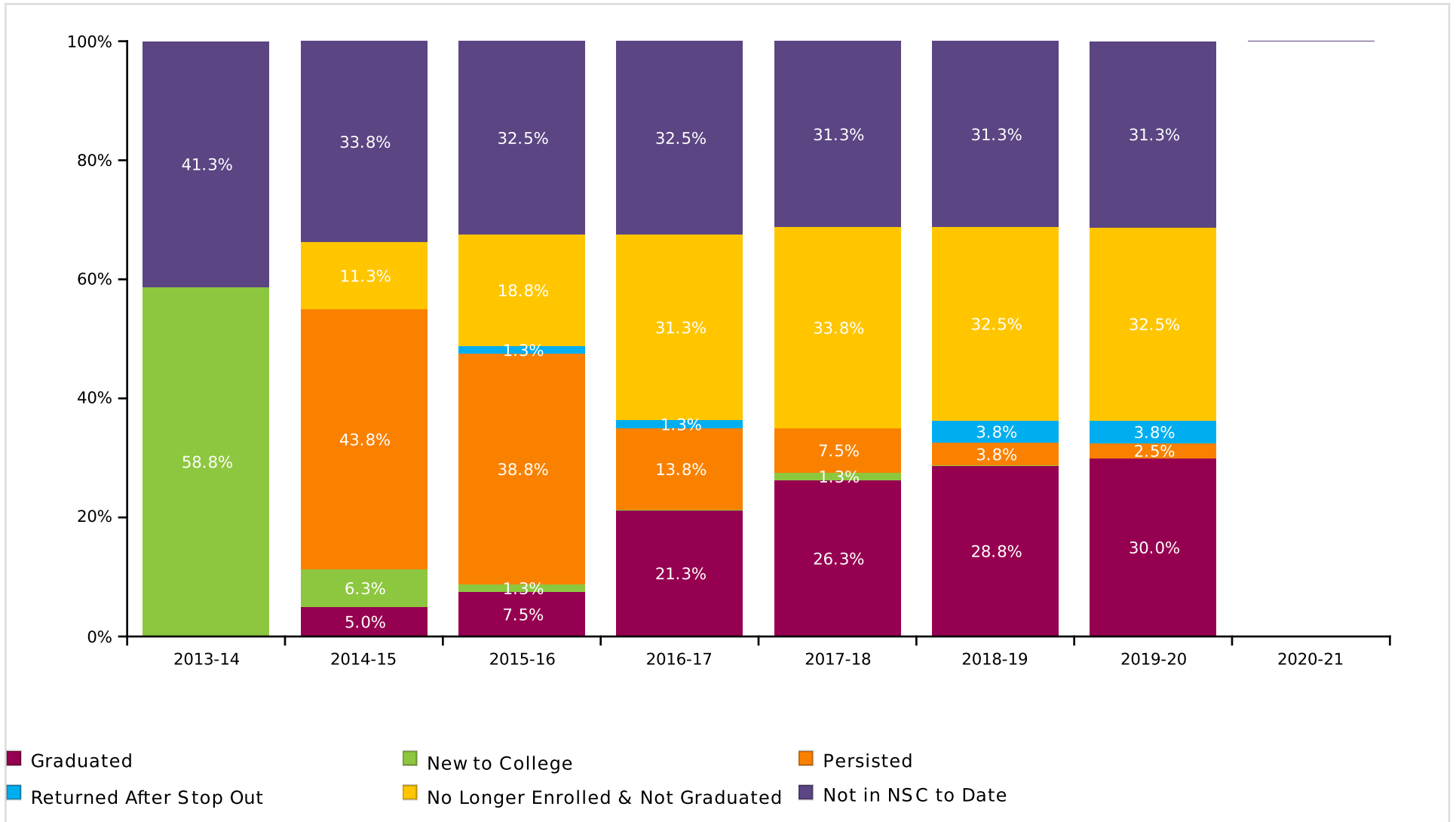

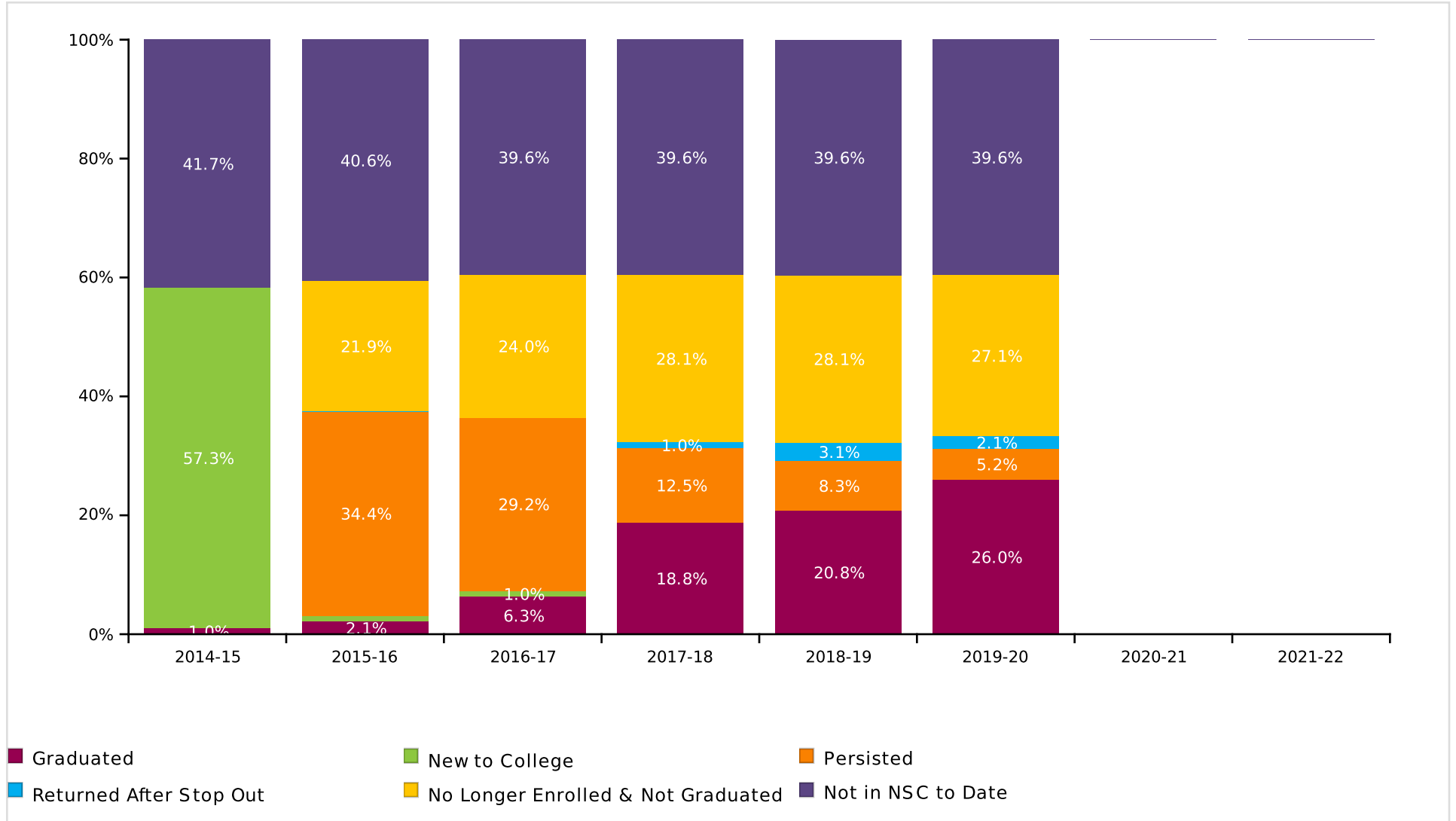

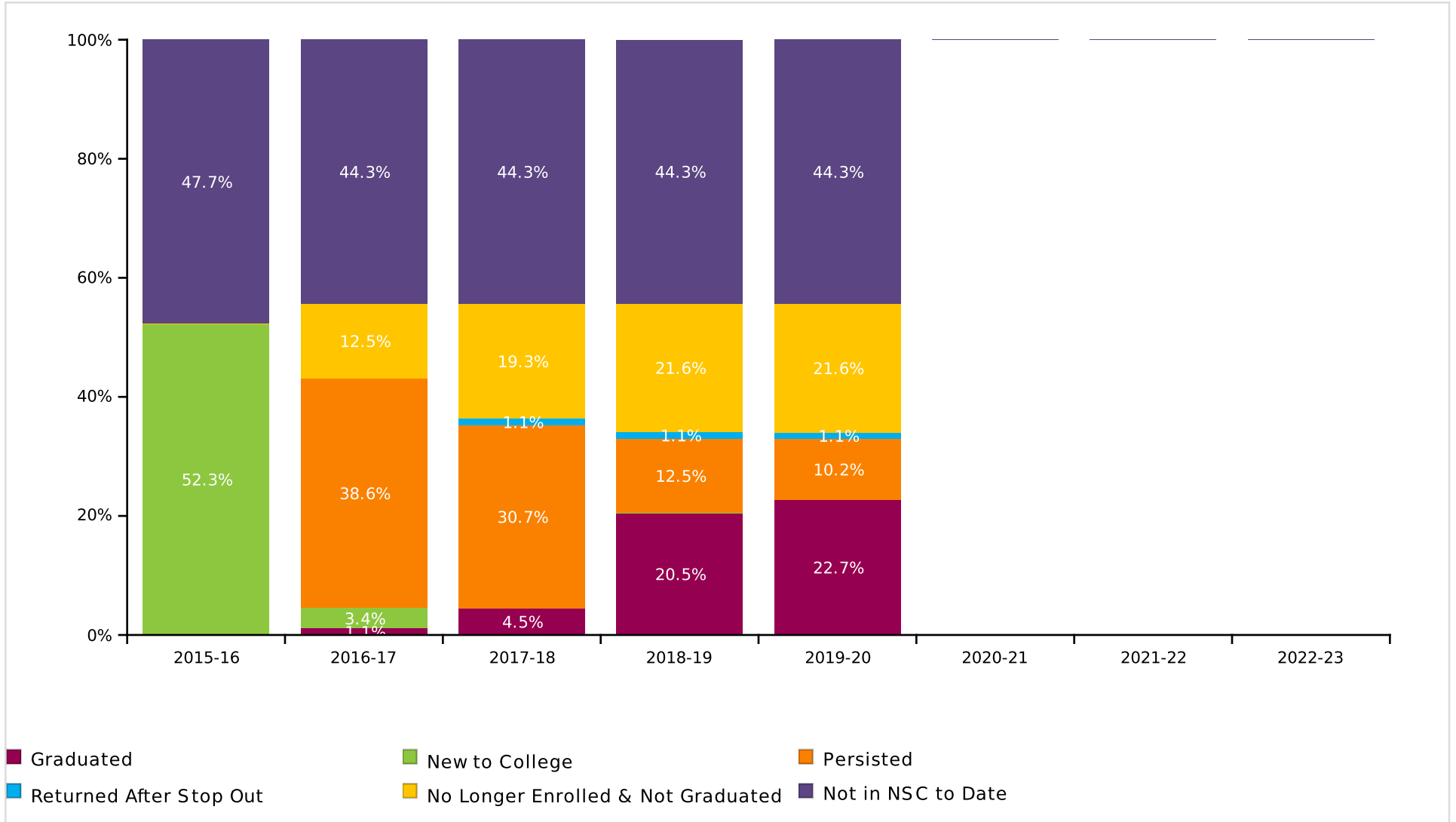

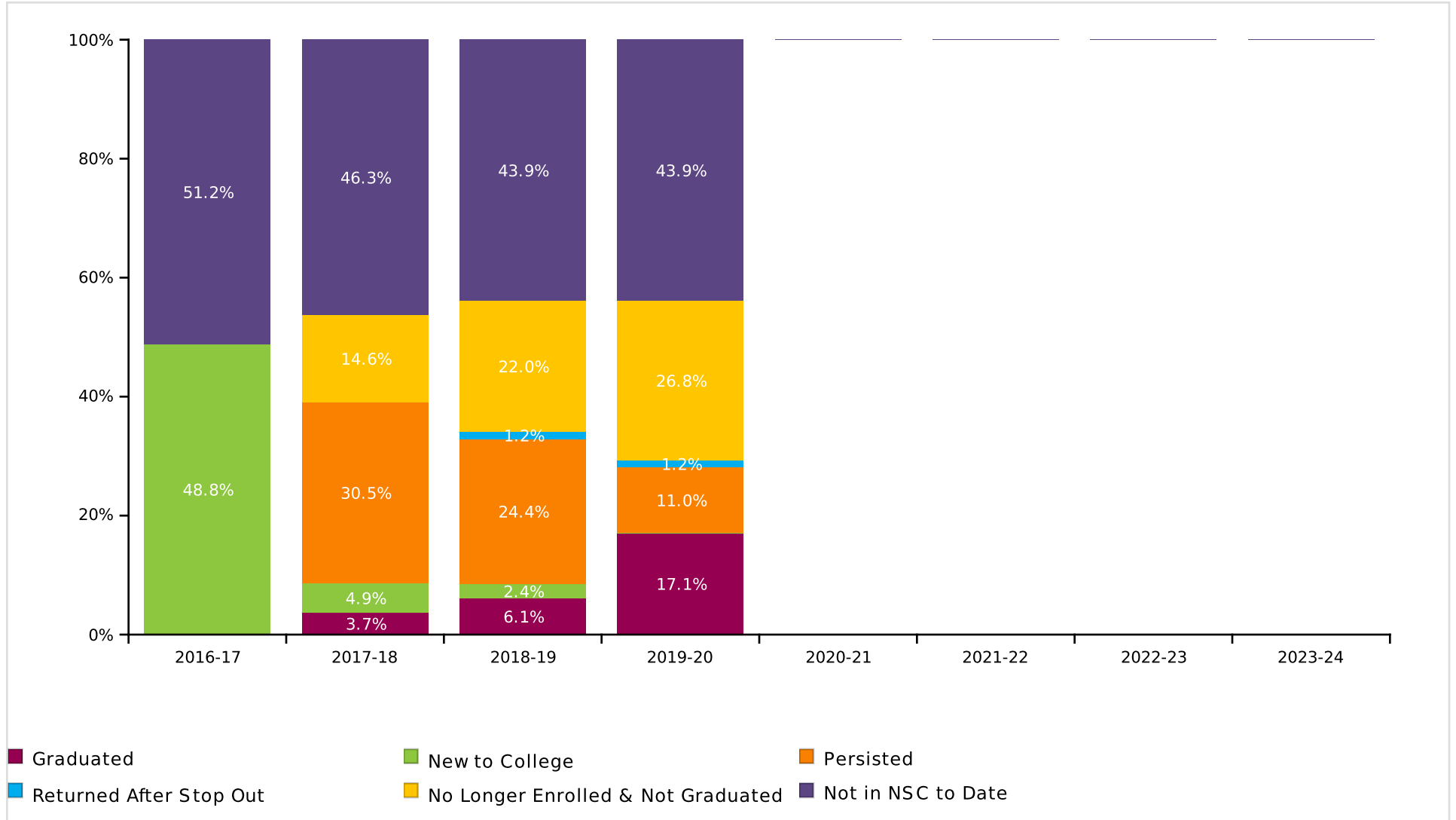

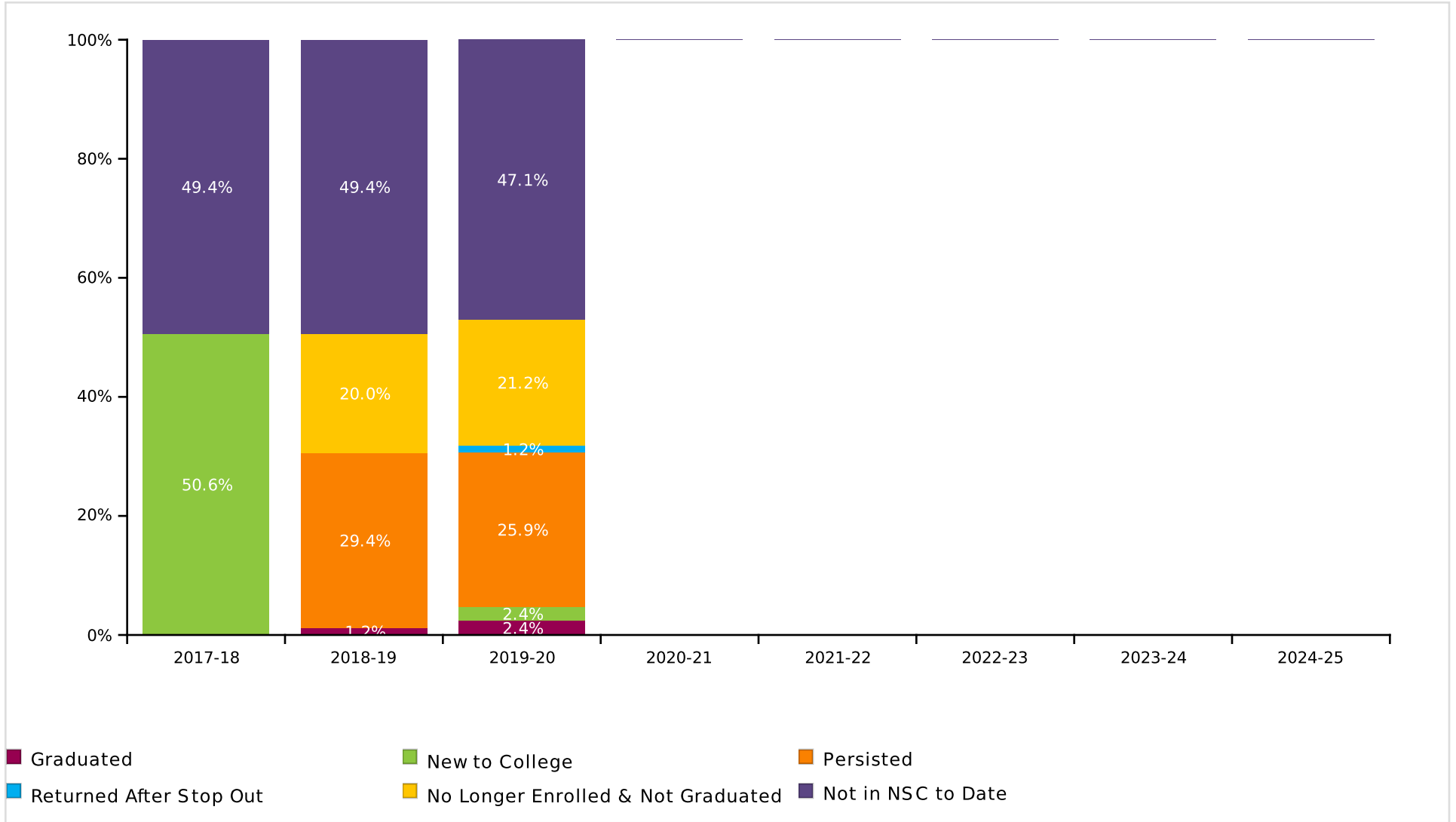

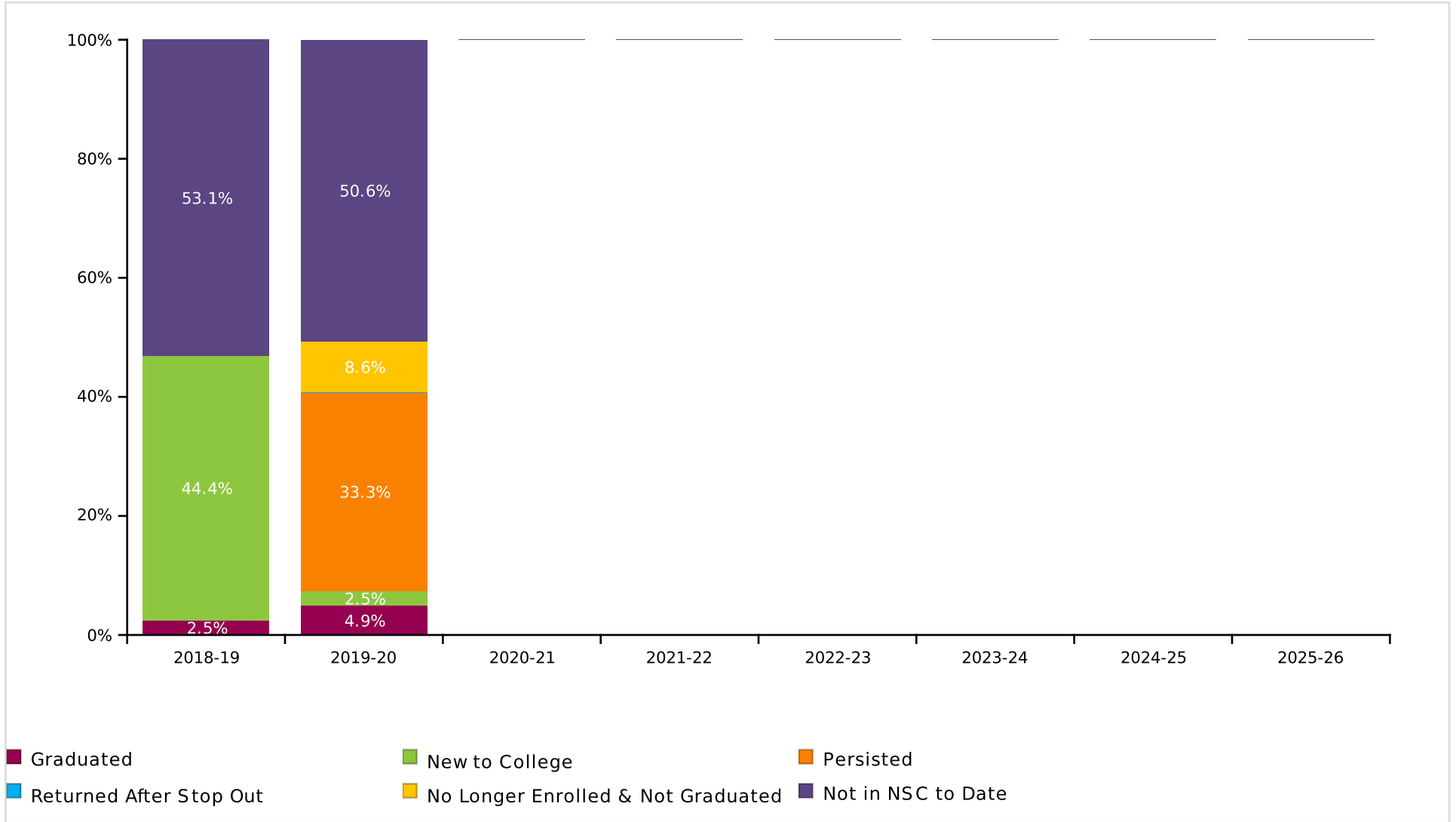

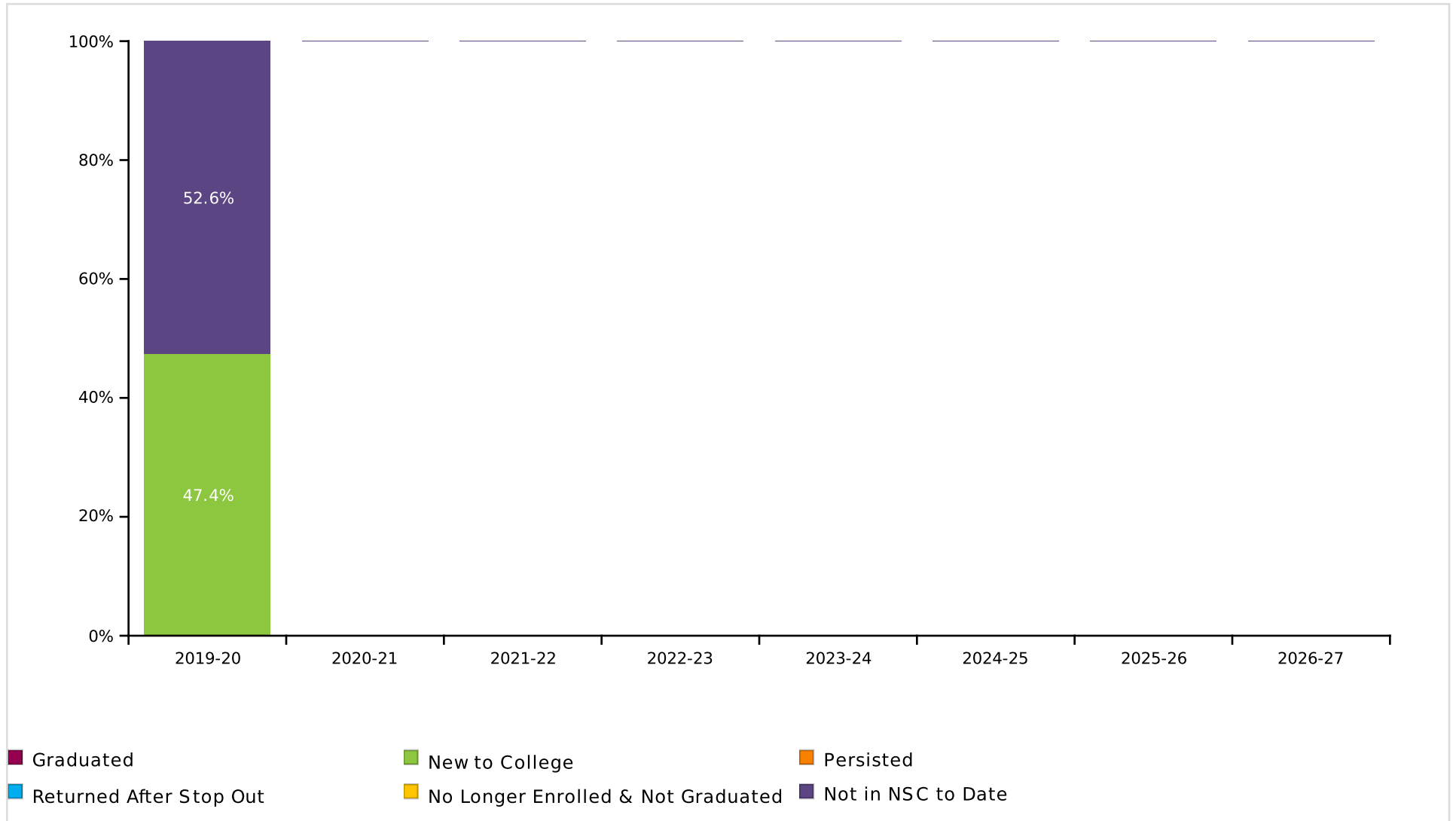
