

  - New Assessment Management System
    - New process for registration
  - Transitioning to device agnostic assessment
  - Using school internet
  - Need both a School Coordinator (main point of contact) & Onsite Technology Coordinator
    - Must be onsite to assist on the date of assessment administration
- Upcoming steps
  - Assessment Details communication
  - Qualtrics Survey (linked in the communication)
  - District Assessment Coordinators receive "CC" for all communications
  - DACs can request access via email <u>regina.lewis@maine.gov</u>


- Request Access

- Forward any changes in Principals at schools selected for NAEP


