



















Unit 3 Clue game descriptions:

Sombrero

- 1. This is a Spanish word for a kind of hat that is very big.

Pinwheels

- 1. This is a toy that spins when the wind moves it. It turns so fast that sometimes part of it becomes a blur.

- *3.* This word begins with /p/.

Clothespins

- 1. "This is a kind of clip that holds the wash on the line to dry. The wind sometimes pulls these off the line.
- 2. This word begins with /k/.

Sailboat

- 1. This is a kind of ship that moves through the water with the help of the wind.
- 2. Gilberto played with one of these on the water.
- 3. This word begins with /s/

Bumble bee

- 1. This is a kind of insect.
- 2. This insect is yellow and black and makes a buzzing sound. This insect can sting you.
- 3. This insect's name begins with /b/.

Clover

- 1. This is the name of a flower the baby rabbits liked to nibble the blossoms of this flower.
- 2. The name of this flower starts with the sounds /k//l/.

Grasshopper

- 1. These are also insects, but they don't sting us. They can jump very high.
- 2. The name of this insect begins with $\frac{g}{a}$ and the next sound in the word is $\frac{r}{a}$.

Spider

- 1. This animal spins a web.
- 2. Its name begins with the sounds $\frac{s}{p}$.

Footprints

- 1. These are the marks left by your shoes or books in snow or mud.
- 2. This word begins with /f/.

Hood

This is the part of a winter coat that covers your head. It is attached to a coat or snowsuit.

Peter wore this when he played out in the snow.

This word begins with /h/.

Boot

- 1. We wear these on our feet when it is rainy or snowy.
- 2. Peter wore these to keep him feet warm and dry when he played out in the snow.
- 3. This word begins with /b/.
