NIC Insurance Filings, Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Statement of Work and Schedule A

Dan Andrews provided an overview of the project. The insurance filings service is offered by NIC that is in use by 20+ states at present. It allows insurance companies to submit proof of liability insurance to the state on behalf of the drivers they insure that have SR22

filings on record. The bureau has been using this for commercial filings, but now would like to expand that to personal filings as well. This will replace the paper and manual process the bureau has in place at present and create efficiencies for the bureau.

A. Fourth Quarter General Manager's Report
