Jones Plastic conducted an investigation into a security incident that resulted in unauthorized access to its network. Upon learning of the unauthorized access, Jones Plastic immediately took steps to secure its network, contacted law enforcement, and began an investigation with the assistance of a cybersecurity firm. The investigation determined that between May 27, 2021 and June 12, 2021, an unauthorized party accessed certain files saved to Jones Plastics' file systems. Jones Plastic reviewed the files that may have been involved. On September 16, 2021, Jones Plastic determined that one or more of those files contained personal information of three Maine residents, including their names and Social Security numbers.

On November 11, 2021, Jones Plastic is providing written notice via United States Postal Service First Class Mail to the Maine residents whose personal information was potentially accessed by the unauthorized party, in accordance with Me. Rev. Stat. Tit. 10, §1348.¹ Jones Plastic is offering the individuals a complimentary, one-year membership to credit monitoring and identity theft prevention services through Kroll, which includes Credit Monitoring, Fraud Consultation, and Identity Theft Restoration. Jones Plastic is encouraging the affected individuals to remain vigilant by reviewing their accounts for unauthorized activity.

To reduce the risk of a similar incident in the future, Jones Plastic has implemented additional safeguards and technical security measures, including implementation of an Endpoint Detection and Response package, enhanced email monitoring, and multifactor authentication for domain administrator access.
