This is a supplemental notification by our client, Fort Hays State University Foundation, to provide additional information regarding the Blackbaud vendor incident that we reported to your office on October 13, 2020 and February 12, 2021.

Since our prior notifications, Fort Hays State University Foundation has identified an additional 30 Maine residents whose name and Social Security number were contained in the Blackbaud database. The investigation is now concluded.

Beginning today, April 16, 2021, Fort Hays State University Foundation is providing written notice to these additional Maine residents by mailing letters via United States Postal Service First-Class mail in the same form as the sample we previously provided to your office.¹

The total number of Maine residents notified by Fort Hays State University Foundation of this incident is 32. Fort Hays State University Foundation is offering all Maine residents a complimentary, two-year membership to credit monitoring and identity theft prevention services through Experian, CyberScout, or Kroll. Fort Hays State University Foundation is recommending that the individuals remain vigilant to the possibility of fraud by reviewing their account statements for unauthorized activity. Fort Hays State University Foundation has also established a dedicated phone number where the individuals may obtain more information regarding the incident.
