CBIZ, Inc. is providing an update regarding the MOVEit security incident that we reported to your office on September 1, 2023.¹ CBIZ has continued to work with its clients to identify individuals whose information was involved and identify addresses for those individuals. CBIZ has now mailed notification letters via United States Postal Service First-Class mail to a total of 482 Maine residents in accordance with Me. Rev. Stat. Tit. 10, § 1348.² The personal information varied by Maine resident but included one or more of the following: name, Social Security number, driver's license number and/or financial account number. CBIZ is offering complimentary credit monitoring, fraud consultation, and identity theft restoration services through Kroll to all Maine residents whose Social Security number or driver's license number was involved in the incident.
